10:35 – Meeting **called to order**. Eric Herman reviewed the agenda and strategies for the day.

Review minutes from the June meeting: Motion made and carried to approve the minutes with correction to the attendance list.

Chair Report on Follow-up Items

Eric led a discussion of action items from our June meeting including a chart showing [historic Council membership](#), which is posted on the Clearinghouse. Other newly posted items are the revised [GAC governance document](#), and an updated [welcome from the GIO](#).

Council Membership

Jeff Herter led a discussion regarding the makeup of the Council. Historically, the representation by sector has been guided by the counts of membership of the GIS Data Sharing Cooperative. Jeff provided a handout with suggestions that we instead mirror the membership of NYS GIS Association membership counts. **Julie Tolar, Bill Johnson and Jeff Herter will participate in an ad-hoc committee, and will address this further at our next meeting.**

Nominating Committee

Glen Cutter has declined to run for a second term.

Jim Daly had resigned his current term. Jim was serving as the Vice Chair.

Sheri Norton has also decided to decline to run for a second term.

Ann Deakin's term is expiring, and she is eligible for a second term.

Alex Chaucer's term is expiring, and he is eligible for a second term.

Craig Chessman's term is expiring, and he is not eligible for another term.

Dough Freehafer's term is expiring and he is eligible for another term.

A nominating committee is needed to propose a slate of candidates following the new guidelines in the guidance document. **Sheri Norton, Craig Cheeseman, and Dave Jorgensen volunteered to participate. We will ask Todd Nelson to participate as well. Sheri will chair the group.**

By October 15 a list of open positions should go to the Association. By November 25, we need a list of recommendations back from the Association.

Eric also noted that the timing for electing a Chairman needs to be changed, since the group would need to vote on whether to retain incumbents before voting on a Chair. **Eric will work on the revision to the Governance Document.**

Joint Update from GPO Director & GIO

Frank and Bill discussed the current expansion of the GIS Program Office, and build-out of the new GIS Core Services Group. Frank is heading the entire GPO, and Marty Goldblatt has assumed Frank's previous role. A good deal of attention is now coming from executive leadership, with regard to the new [NY-Responds](#) program.

Afternoon Planning Session

The Committee spent the balance of the meeting reviewing and discussing progress to date and future plans for the recommendations of the [2008 Strategic Plan](#).

Of particular interest were these topics:

- Statewide parcel data program
- Statewide GIS enterprise architecture and web services delivery platform
- Statewide elevation data program
- Strengthen and expand the existing statewide orthoimagery program to include a wider variety of products such as elevation and oblique imagery
- The future of the Data Sharing Cooperative
- Improving the utility and usability of the Clearinghouse
