



Adding a Web Service to ArcGIS


1. Open ArcCatalog and navigate to 'Add ArcGIS Server' in the Catalog Tree window.




2. Double click on Add ArcGIS Server and make sure the next window has 'Use GIS Services' radio button filled in and click next.



3. Next, you will need to add the link to the web service. The link is <https://gisservices.its.ny.gov/arcgis/rest/services>



4. In your list under GIS Servers, you will now see a new item named “arcgis on gisservices.its.ny.gov”



5. When you double click on the new GIS Server, you will see a list of the available services within the Contents Pane of ArcCatalog.
6. Drag and drop the layer(s) into ArcMap from ArcCatalog or add them as you would any other layer.
