

Miscellaneous Points - PLACETYPE

Addressed Feature (not associated with a building)	Examples
Bench	park bench
Boat Site	dock, pier, slip, boat launch, boat launch ramp, marinas
Bridge	
Campsite	camp site, lean-to
Cemetery	
Culvert	
Dam	
ESN Line	ESN, fire, police, or EMS boundary line
Fuel Source	Storage tanks for chemical, fuel, oil, propane; gas well; oil well
Gate	locked gate, locked drive, chained drive
Landing Zone	Helipad, landing strip, runway, sea plane base
Intersection	road/road, road/railroad, road/trail, trail/trail, highway exit, on ramp, off ramp, crossover/emergency turnaround
Kiosk	ATM, bus stop, mailboxes (mobile home park), food stands
Milemarker	mile markers, rail trails, hiking trails, bike trails: all with whole number addresses
Monument	statue, monument, fountain, "memorial park"
Municipal Boundary Line	county, city, town, or village boundary line
Parking Lot	trailhead, snowmobile, horse, park and ride
Phone	pay phone, telephone booth, emergency phone
Public Recreation Area	beach, park, picnic area, playground, sports court, ball field, overlooks, pull off area
Road End	dead end, public maintenance end point
Subterranean	Access to coal mines, salt mines, ore mines, caves, quarry, gravel mine
Tower	antenna, cell, communications, radio, TV, repeater, lookout, fire
Trailhead	Where a trail begins or ends
Utility	street light, utility pole, junction box, meter, billboard, gas valve, manhole cover, water valve, pump station, positive train control, solar array, water treatment plant, knox box, dumpsters (campground), transfer station
Water Body	pond, lake, reservoir, water falls, gorge
Water Source	water tower, water storage tank, hydrants, dry hydrants, public water supply well

Vanity Address	An address used by a residence/business that is not recognized by 911. An example would be a corner lot where they are using the wrong street name.
