- Review of NYSDOT UAS Progress
 - UAS planning committee to set policies and procedures to set the standard operating procedures for managing the drone project.
 - Over 150 Missions flown for 2024
 - 12 drones in NYSDOT fleet for various cases
 - Plans for a Tether drone for live stream and traffic monitoring also lidar capable, construction monitoring
 - Drones will be used as a complementary technology
 - Drones are only used for small projects whereas the state-wide orthos are better for large projects. Higher resolution small area
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- About the Drones:
 - Autel Evo II enterprise Bundle – Best camera and best battery life available
 - Remote ID compliant – feds requirement
 - ADS-B is the system used to detect other aircraft
 - Multiple people needed on each drone team – 1 Pilot, 1 Visual Observer, and 1 Support personnel
